BC3 president gets Pacesetter award

BUTLER TWP — Butler County Community College President Nick Neupauer has been named a regional Pacesetter award winner by the National Council for Marketing and Public Relations.

The award recognizes leaders with communications expertise.

Neupauer said he is honored to receive the award in District 1, which includes leaders of community colleges and technical schools in New England, Maryland and Pennsylvania.

“I am humbled ... I have emphasized communication with our internal, external, and really, media audiences ever since I’ve been president in 2007,” Neupauer said. “This award would indicate we’re doing a very good job in providing solid communication skills to all of those groups.”

He was nominated by BC3 spokeswoman Susan Changnon. Neupauer will accept his award at a regional conference in Mystic, Conn., next month, along with Changnon.

He is among seven regional winners who will be considered for the national NCMPR Pacesetter award next year.
